## **TERMS and CONDITIONS** **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

### **For Club Membership purposes:**

- Juniors are defined as being under 18 on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2010

**For racing purposes, we are advised by our insurers and the RYA that we should consider Juniors as those aged 14 or under (on March 1<sup>st</sup> 2010)**

- Family membership (1) covers all boats owned within the family.
- Family Racing, Racing and Junior – memberships (1) (2) and (3) entitles the named members to helm in all events and racing organised by BSC, (refer also to sailing instructions). Fees will be payable to enter the Blakeney and Morston Regatta and any open events as designated by the Committee.
- Members who take the non racing option but wish to participate in club racing, as above, agree to pay £5 per race which will be invoiced to them by the Membership Secretary. Money should **not** be given to the Officer of the Day
- Boat ownership includes dinghies, sailboards, catamarans, canoes, keelboats, cruisers and motorboats.
- Supporter and friend membership includes owners of canoes and motorboats.
- Each named member is entitled to use the Club House and to vote at the AGM.
