## **NOTES ON THE PROGRAMME**

**All flying start races will be started with the 5 minute rule.**

Class flag raised 5 minutes before the start.

Flag 'P' raised 4 minutes before the start.

Flag 'P' lowered 1 minute before the start.

Class flag lowered at start.

These events will be accompanied by a sound signal.

### **Junior Series**

Throughout the season the results of any junior competing in the racing will be recorded as a separate series and a cup/prizes will be presented at the end of the season for the winner (and runner up if enough compete)

### **Race Series**

There will be three race series. 2 or more discards will be allowed. Where normal weekend racing is also scheduled, these races will take preference but race positions will also be added to the series.

On days when the tide depth is less than 7.7 metres there may not be sufficient water to hold a race if the wind is a strong easterly.

### **Race Types**

Race Type 1 Flying start(s) from 'Lapwing'  
Finish 'Lapwing'

Race Type 2 Bank Start Blakeney, Regatta course  
Finish in Blakeney Cut

Race Type 3 Bank Start Blakeney, Regatta course  
Finish in Morston

Race Type 4 Start and finish in Blakeney Cut at Cooke or Simms posts.

Race Type 4a Flying start from 'Lapwing' finish in Blakeney Cut at Cooke or Simms posts

\* Asterisks denote Cup presentation dates. Up to Aug. 31st. Presentations will be made in the Clubhouse on the last day of each series as soon as possible after racing.

\*\* Presentations for Regatta Week races will be made after racing on Sunday the 23<sup>rd</sup> August.
